Dear Parent/Carer,

RE: Twilight Bus Service – Blue Route

I am writing to advise you of some changes to the Twilight Bus Service Blue Route. The Blue Route was funded by East Riding of Yorkshire Council. Unfortunately this funding will come to an end at the end of the spring term and therefore we have had to look into alternative provisions for the Blue Route.

Due to being unable to get a company with a larger vehicle available, we are making the following changes to the Blue Route from the start of the summer term:

- The Blue Route will no longer go to Nafferton, serving only Wansford, Brigham, North Frodingham and Beeford. All students who currently use the Blue Route to travel to Nafferton will need to use the Orange Route instead. The Orange Route offers three different options – the 121 service that leaves from Bridlington Road at either 4.35pm or 5.35pm; and the 46 service that leaves from Bridlington Road at 5.15pm
- For students travelling to Wansford, Brigham, North Frodingham and Beeford, they will need to book a seat on the service by 1.20pm on the day of travel in the LRC. This will enable staff in the LRC to book the required number of vehicles with KC Cars for the route on each given evening. If students do not book a seat, then travel on the route will not be guaranteed as there may not be the capacity to transport them.

We are delighted to be able to continue the Blue Route which, along with our whole Twilight Bus programme, allows students to stay after school to undertake sports clubs, activities, intervention classes, revision classes and to utilise the Learning Resource Centre.
