**Safety Week**

The week commencing 22.1.18 will be our first Safety Week as part of the Form Time Programme. We are using this week to promote safety issues for young people.

- An opportunity to complete an 'emotion' map of the school – this will encourage them to share information about where they feel comfortable on school and which areas we need to consider improved supervision.

During this week, we will also be gathering anonymous student views about their understanding of our safeguarding processes and procedures and any suggestions on how we can improve site safety.
