## **Lateral Flow Testing – registration for students**



When students complete their COVID-19 Lateral Flow Test they will be given a registration card which will have their test barcode on it so that they can register their test and receive their result by text message and/or email.

All students can register their test online so that they receive their results. Students over 13 years of age can also register for an NHS account which they can use as part of their test registration. Those students aged 13 and under cannot register for an NHS account but can still register their test online so that they, or their parents, can receive their result.

When students complete their lateral flow test they will have a registration card with their test barcode stuck on it. They will need to use this barcode to register their test. They will also need the site ID for Driffield School which is DRRD.

## **Instructions for registering a Lateral Flow Test:**

- Go to: <a href="https://test-for-coronavirus.service.gov.uk/register-kit">https://test-for-coronavirus.service.gov.uk/register-kit</a>
- Click on 'Start now'
- Click on 'myself'
- Student aged 13 and under should click 'Register without using NHS login'. Students aged 14 and over can 'Register using NHS login' and then log in with their detail.
- You will then be prompted to enter their barcode from the test. If using a phone or tablet they can use their camera to scan the barcode (webcams will also work for this).
- You will then be prompted to input the site ID. This is **DRRD**.
- They will then need to confirm the test site is Driffield School & Sixth Form and then should select 'I went to this test site'.
- You will now be promoted to answer a series of questions, including personal details. It is important that these are correct, otherwise they may not receive their test result. They will be asked to confirm all their information at the end of the process before submitting.
- Students should retain their registration card and barcode until they have received their results by
  either text or email. Should you not receive a text or email with your result then we can use this
  barcode to check the result on our records. We will however contact you should the result be
  positive.
