If you were able to make it to the Sixth Form information evening last week, I hope that you and your child found the event informative and helpful. Please be aware that whilst an early application secures students a place at the Sixth Form pending their GCSE results, students are not committed to the subjects they choose at this point. Students will be offered an opportunity to change their subject choices throughout Year 11, so that we can ensure that they start their studies on the subjects that are right for them and their career choices. Students can also submit a paper application which they received on the evening. If they were unable to attend and didn't receive one, they can collect one from the Sixth Form office.

To help students consider the range of opportunities that are available after the completion of GCSEs, including which subject combinations may be the best for them, all students will receive an interview with a member of the Senior Leadership team over the next three weeks. There will also be an opportunity to complete an application at this point.
