We are now over half way through a busy half term and it has been a pleasure to see how students – in all year groups – continue to work hard in lessons.

Year 11 and Year 13 are currently preparing for their mock exams and we have recently shared information regarding our Trust's 'No Student Left Behind' Programme. All students in Years 11 and 13 have been given a £50 allocation to purchase revision materials from a menu of resources and we are currently in the process of ordering these to support them with their revision at home.

- As part of our APEX curriculum this term, students are learning about the importance of healthy relationships.
