## V Yorkshire Wolds Virtual Teacher Training Experience 2020-21

Last month, 120 students from 12 local 6th form colleges, including yours, attended the **Yorkshire Wolds Virtual Teacher Training Experience**.

This innovative programme is one of the first of its kind to launch in the UK and aims to provide Post 16 students and undergraduates with information about the routes into teaching and develop the skills needed to create a stand out CV and application for teacher training courses in the future.

The students were given a presentation on the benefits and rewards of teaching, information on the financial support that is available for those wishing to apply for teacher training places after their degree and information on what the different providers can offer. The students then completed a masterclass in resource development and lesson planning; which are both crucial skills for the teaching profession and spent some time creating resources for our charity



schools in Kenya and Laos. The resources will be sent to the two overseas schools to enhance teaching and learning there as there are currently no CPD opportunities for staff.

This project will not only allow the students on the programme to develop excellent resource development and lesson planning skills but it will also increase the creativity of lessons in Kenya and Laos to allow their students to also reach their limitless potential.

Those signed up to the programme can choose to complete additional sessions on behaviour management and differentiation and will continue to collaborate with the teachers and students in Kenya and Laos to build more creative resources and support the professional development of their staff.

Graduates of our virtual programme will not only benefit from an amazing set of experiences to include on their job applications and CVs, but will also join the **Yorkshire Wolds Teacher Training Guaranteed Interview Scheme** which will enable those on the course to return for a teacher training interview in the future.
