Thank you all for your support and feedback over our first few weeks back, especially when it comes to our revised routines in school and the staggered start/end times. We've worked hard as a school community over the past week to adapt to our new social distancing measures, including one-way systems, staggered breaks/lunches, revised classroom layouts and hand sanitisation routines.

To support students who may be self-isolating, we've also gone through the Microsoft Teams platform with all students. That video guide can be found at this link, or on the main school website. Where students are off, they are able to login and follow their timetable from home, with live lessons where the whole class is off and lesson resources supplied where this is not the case (apart from practical subjects, like P.E., where remote work isn't set). Students can log into Teams using their school email/password through the Microsoft Teams app (on a phone/tablet/computer) or through a web browser. This will then give them access to resources to catch-up on missed lessons, or to check their homework tasks. If absent students have issues logging on at home, they can contact the school office for support.

## Full School Information

- Update letters from the CEO and Executive Principal were sent on 16 September and 3 September.
- Key information for the wider reopening of schools was shared at the end of August, including frequently asked questions and details of the new school day.

A quick guide to the daily timings has been shared with all students.

- Information from Public Health England on how we can work together to make sure we can continue to give children the best education in the safest was possible has been shared.
- Stay at home guidance for households with a possible or confirmed coronavirus infection has been shared in line with information from Public Health England.
- Guidance was provided on our approach to face coverings in school on 11 September and 14 September.
- We continue to place a high priority on the mental health of everyone involved in school life. Support for children's emotional wellbeing with the return to school has been shared, with helpful resources from the Hull and East Riding Child and Adolescent Mental Health Service.
- Updated guidance from the East Riding of Yorkshire Council in relation to home to school transport has been circulated prior to the start of term.
- For health and safety reasons in Drama and Dance studio spaces, we have asked students to bring with them clean, dry indoor trainers for these areas.
