RE: 121 and 122 Nafferton and Bridlington School Bus Services

All school bus services are resuming on Monday 29 June, which includes the 121 and 122 Nafferton and Bridlington School Bus Services.

I am writing to remind you that EYMS have made some changes to the services, which were due to commence from 20 April. There will now be just two bus services, both of which will begin in Bridlington and both of which will pick up in Nafferton. Following further deliberation, EYMS have decided to keep the 121 school bus running to/from Bridlington Bus Station which will minimise any change for students getting on around the Hilderthorpe Road area. At Ruston Parva, on a morning students will need to walk to the top end of the village to avoid the bus having to turn right at the Crossroads onto the A614, as some parents expressed concerns about the safety of this junction. The bus will instead run down New Road to a safer junction onto the A614. The students can be dropped off in the village on an afternoon.
