I hope that you and your family are keeping well during this difficult time. We continue to look forward to a point in the future when we will be able to return to a more normal situation and see you all back in school.

We are starting to plan for September and we do employ Sixth Form Students, often referred to as 'yellow coats' by students, to work with our staff supervising students at lunchtime both in the canteen areas and in the outdoor areas of the school. This is a good way to earn extra money as the school's rate is almost double the national minimum wage normally paid by local businesses (£4.55 per hour), as well as being useful work experience which you can share with future employers or prospective universities and colleges.
