


How to register for an NHS Login

Registering for an NHS Login prior to rapid testing saves time for you or your child in the testing centre. Children over 13 can register for an NHS Login but may require the assistance of an adult.


To register yourself or your child you should click the following link which will take to the NHS Login service:


You should click the option for 'myself' if you are registering yourself or supporting your child to create a login.





You should then choose the option to 'register using and NHS Login'.





You will be asked to enter your email address. *This will be your/your child's username so it is important that this email address is not already registered for an NHS login.* Your child will have a school email address although you may choose to use their home email address if you prefer. You need to be able to access this account as a confirmation email will be sent to it.




You will need to create a password for the account. It needs to be something you or your child will be able to remember as you/they will need to input this at the testing centre. You will be asked to check your emails to confirm this.



You will then receive an email to your/your child's email address asking you to confirm that you have registered for an account. You will be able to go back into your NHS login and it will confirm that you have a registered account.



You will be asked to input a mobile phone number where you want the outcome of the test to sent to.




At this stage you have registered your account and you/your child will be able to register a test using a barcode given to them at the testing centre.

How to register a test


At the testing site you will be given a test card and a unique bar code. You will be able to scan in a QR code to take you straight to the link below which will take to the NHS Login service:

You should click the option for 'myself'.



You should then choose the option to 'register using and NHS Login' (if you have already registered following the instructions above) and you will be asked for your username and password. This is the email address that you gave above and the password that you created.



You then choose the option to register a test using the unique barcode given to you at the test centre. You can scan this or input it manually. This process links the test that you take your details and enables you to receive the outcome of the test via text.
