RE: Year 10 GCSE Geography Field Trip

I am writing to you regarding the Year 10 GCSE Geography field trip. This is scheduled to take place on Monday 5 July 2021. The trip will leave Driffield School at approximately 9.00 am and will return by the end of the school day. Students will visit York city centre and will be spending much of the day collecting data for their paper 2 exam which they will sit in May 2022.

Students should be dressed in suitable clothing, not school uniform, and wear suitable footwear, not flip-flops or sandals. Students should bring a water proof coat in case of wet weather and should apply sun cream in case of good weather. Lastly, students will need to bring a packed lunch as there will be no opportunity to purchase food on the trip.
