Dear Parent or Carer,

**RE: Sixth Form Open Evening**

We are delighted to invite you and your child to our Sixth Form Open Evening on Thursday 4 November 2021 so that we can provide you with the opportunity to explore the range of courses available to your child at our highly successful Sixth Form. You will also be provided with important information and dates relating to your child's GCSE courses on the same evening.

We are pleased to inform you that we will be holding this event in person. We have, however, had to put in place some mitigations as part of our Covid Risk Assessment and this is outlined in the information below.

The event will run between 6.00 pm and 8.00 pm and, to avoid large gatherings, will operate on a carousel format; ensuring that there are plenty of opportunities to visit subject areas to view A Level courses and meet our departmental staff, who will also be available to answer any queries you may have about their courses.

Mrs Loftus' talk in East Hall will provide important information regarding upcoming dates for students and it will include tips and advice about how you can best support your child through their final GCSE year.
