Dear Parent or Carer,

RE: Extra-Curricular Opportunities for Students

We are delighted to inform you of the extra-curricular opportunities available to students this term. As a school, we have always offered a wide range of enrichment opportunities to students (both at lunchtimes and after school) and encourage them to take part in activities outside of their timetabled lessons. Our aim is to provide memorable experiences outside of the classroom that will enrich their school experience and support their personal development.

After a year-long closure (due to Covid-19), we are also pleased to welcome students back into the school's Learning and Resource Centre (LRC). All students in Years 7, 8 and 9 will have a fortnightly slot in their English lessons to exchange books and browse the wide range of titles on offer. The LRC is also open at breaktimes for reading; as well as lunchtimes and after-school (on Monday and Thursdays until 5 pm) for students to loan books, read, or use the space to study independently.

Our twilight buses run on Monday and Thursday evenings. Our non-service bus routes will leave at 4.45 pm (as all extra-curricular sessions finish at 4.30 pm). Students should contact Ace Reception at 4.45 pm in the unlikely event that their bus or taxi hasn't arrived. These buses leave from the front of the West building:

- Green route
- Blue route
- White route
- Purple route (beyond Wetwang)

The yellow and orange service routes will continue to leave from Bridlington Road and the purple route to Wetwang leaves from the Sports Centre. Students should collect a booklet of tickets from the ACE reception and for travel on the green or purple extension routes, book a seat on the day of travel at the ACE reception by the end of lunchtime. Please ensure that students have a mobile phone in their bags to be able to contact you in the unlikely event that there is an issue with the service route. Please see the attached map for full details of each bus route.

As restrictions have now eased, we also look forward to planning school trips again this year and enabling students to access a range of enrichment opportunities. Details for specific trips will be shared with you throughout the year.
