RE: Uniform

As the term draws to a close, we would like to thank you for your on-going support in ensuring your children attend school wearing the correct uniform.

Please note, where windows are open during lessons for ventilation purposes, students will be permitted to wear an outdoor coat to keep warm. Although students are not required to wear both a jumper and blazer, they may wish to during the colder weather and must be wearing at least one of these items when they arrive to school and as they move around the site.

We are mindful that some students may require replacement uniform for the new term, so we wanted to refresh everyone on the dress code. Details can be found at the following link:

A number of high street fashion stores often label clothing as 'Back to School' or 'School Wear' that do may not meet our uniform requirements. This is particularly the case for trousers, and we would like to remind parents and carers that the requirement is for students to wear formal, classic smart trousers. Unfortunately, leggings, jeans or sports trousers of any type are not permitted.

Finally, we would also ask for your support on piercings. Other than one piercing in each ear, piercings are not permitted and therefore students will be asked to remove them in school. The Christmas holidays is unfortunately not a suitable time for a young person to have additional piercings as they do not have time for it to sufficiently heal before term starts.
