We are writing to confirm that the annual Year 11 Prom will be held at the Beverley Race Course, Beverley, HU17 8QZ on Friday 15 July. Students should begin arriving from 6.30 pm onwards and all students need to be seated by 7.15 pm. The meal will be served at 7.30 pm, followed by dancing until 11.30 pm.

The tickets will cost £30 and will include a two course meal, professional photographs and access to the photo booth. Students may wish to purchase soft drinks from the bar. The preferred and most efficient method of payment for the tickets is via Parent Pay. In exceptional cases we are able to accept receipt of cash. Further details will be sent to you about this event later in the school year.

Students who have achieved 1200 stamps may choose to use these rewards to receive £10 towards their ticket price. The deadline to receive the discount is Friday 27 May 2022. If your child has not yet achieved enough stamps, the full ticket price must be paid and the £10 will be refunded once we have received confirmation that the required number of stamps have been achieved. The finance department will contact you regarding the refund and how it will be refunded to you.

Formal photographs will be taken by a professional photographer and will be available on line after the event. The dress code is formal (cocktail dress, long evening dress, suit and tie, or tuxedo).

Based on past experience, students have requested a simple menu as below:


Main Cheeseburger and fries with Salad

We believe this will be an excellent event which everyone attending will enjoy. However, we hope that all students and parents will understand that there is a need for those attending to adhere to the following guidelines:











- Alcohol and cigarettes are not to be brought onto the premises it is a non-smoking venue (this includes toilets and washrooms).
- All students have been made aware that attendance at the school prom is a privilege and in order to be eligible to attend students are expected to have a good behaviour record and have engaged well in lessons.
- Any student who appears to have drunk alcohol before arriving at the venue will not be permitted to attend and parents will be contacted to collect them.
- Staff (including externally hired door staff) will be on duty throughout the evening for the safety of everyone.
- Any student who does not conform to the behaviour code will be asked to leave and parents will be expected to make arrangements for their collection.
- Students are responsible for organising transport home by 11.30pm.
