Dear Parent or Carer,

We are very proud of how our Year 11 students are conducting themselves during the exam period. Our exams team have commented that their behaviour and attitude towards their exams has been exemplary. As we break for the half term, we would like to confirm the final arrangements for when we return.

Year 11 students are expected to attend school as normal until Friday 10 June and when students are not sitting an examination, they are expected to attend their normal timetabled lessons. Now that students have sat some of their exams, it is clearer how the advance information links to actual exam papers. Therefore it is vital that students attend these lessons as class teachers will be focusing on the topics and questions that they feel are the most likely to come up. Friday 10 June will be students' last day following their normal timetable. From Monday 13 June, students are only expected to be in school when they have examinations, though the LRC will be open for Year 11 students to independently revise in school before or after an exam.

Period 6 buses will no longer run after half term, though the Twilight bus service will continue to run as normal on Mondays and Thursday should students wish to revise in school on these evenings (please find a route map attached).

We will be running some revision boosters prior to the final exams. On Saturday 11 June, our maths department will be running an exam booster in North building (9 am - 12 pm). All students are invited to this session and we strongly recommend that they attend as the team will be focusing on the advanced information (as outlined above) for their final maths exam on Monday 13 June.
