RE: National Citizen Service opportunity for all Year 11 students

The National Citizen Service (NCS) is a dynamic, motivational and fun youth programme. It was established in 2011, and aims to build a more cohesive, mobile, and engaged society. It brings young people together from different backgrounds for a unique, fun, shared experience. It helps to build confidence, develop vital employability skills and unlock potential.

This year the NCS will be a five-day, four night residential where young people will be able to try new activities and learn new skills. There are three experience themes available to choose from: 'Live It, Boss It, and Change It'. Live it focuses on survival skills and outdoor pursuits. Boss it focuses on the world of work. Change it focuses on social action helping to improve our local community.

It is a government supported scheme, so the NCS is fantastic value for money – the whole experience costs students only £95. This includes all activities, transport, meals, and accommodation. There are also bursaries available making the NCS accessible to all. The NCS is inclusive and is open to everyone, regardless of their background, capability and circumstances. The NCS offer tailored care plans to students who have additional needs.
