RE: Year 10 GCSE Geography Fieldwork


As you may be aware, Year 10 students are required to undertake fieldwork as a compulsory element of the GCSE Geography course. This will enable them to practise fieldwork techniques and complete an enquiry investigation. This will then form part of their exams in the summer 2024. We would therefore like to take your child out on a day of coastal fieldwork and full details are provided below:

DESTINATION: Hornsea & Skipsea
DATE: 15 June 2023
TIME: 08.45 am meeting in west playground and returning to school for 3.30 pm
METHOD OF TRANSPORT: Bus

Students can wear non-uniform but it is essential to dress for the weather, apply sunscreen and wear suitable shoes for a day at the coast. They will need to bring with them their planners, pencil case and a packed lunch. If your child is eligible for a free school meal, please complete the relevant section on the consent form and a packed lunch will be provided. Following the morning in Hornsea, we are spending the afternoon around Skipsea and will be accessing the beach from Mr Moos Ice cream parlour. Students will have the option to buy an ice cream if they should so wish, so may require a small amount of spending money.

We are asking for a voluntary contribution of £6 per student and this will contribute to the travel costs for the trip. This should be paid via ParentPay by Friday 26 May.
