## CULINARY COOKOFF AT DRIFFIELD SCHOOL

On Monday 17th April the Royal Navy paid a visit to Driffield School and Sixth Form. They guided us through the experience of different individuals working within the royal Navy and taught us a wide variety of skills.

Firstly, the Royal Navy illustrated what working within the force is like and how they are challenged in their work ethic and the things that make them passionate about their job. The hard work and dedication required to work within the Navy is admirable and inspiring. While presenting to the class, the Navy showed us various videos highlighting the wide range of careers available within the Navy. I found the careers that required medical expertise the most intriguing as the video represented the importance of front-line medicine when it comes to supporting and saving lives. This resonated particularly with me as I have an interest in medicine and science and this video enlightened me on the options I have access to.



While educating GCSE food technology students on the work ethic of soldiers within the Navy, they taught the class the importance of teamwork and group co-ordination.

I was tasked with cutting vegetables and preparing the cheese sauce allowing me to cultivate key skills required for the food technology GCSE. In conclusion, the experience provided to us helped our class to gain a better understanding of the significance of the Royal Navy to our country and the importance of key values they prioritise within their work.




