## **RE: Cambridge National - Sports Studies course**

As part of your child's Cambridge National Sports Studies course, they are assessed in R187 Increasing Awareness of Outdoor and Adventurous Activities. In order to undertake this unit, we would like your child to attend a trip to Welton Waters, Common Lane, Brough on Thursday 15 June 2023.

Whilst at Welton Waters, students will take part in the following activities:

- Sailing
- Kayaking
- Raft building
- Paddleboarding

All activities will be supervised by qualified instructors / lifeguards from the activity centre. Due to the nature of the activities being undertaken by the students it is imperative that behaviour is of a high standard. Any students who do not meet these standards may be excluded from the activities with parents/carers being contacted.

Students need to arrive directly to the ACE reception at 8 am to be registered and they will return to school at approximately 3.30 pm. Students do not need to wear school uniform, instead they need to wear comfortable sports clothing e.g. tracksuit, t-shirt, trainers, coat etc.

## Students must bring:

- A packed lunch including drinks
- Swimwear and a towel
- Old trainers / shoes that can get wet
- Dry trainers to come home in
- Change of clothing in case original clothes get wet / dirty
- A bag including carrier bag for wet items
- Suncream in case of warm weather.
