That's why 94% of applicants from our sixth form reach their first choice of destination, way above the national average which is about 66%. In addition, the number of our students going on to study at Russell Group universities (34%) is significantly higher than the national average (12%).


Excellent results

The teaching is excellent and class sizes ensure that getting to know your subject teachers is a lot easier and enables you to get more one to one help. The 2022 results were truly outstanding for Driffield Sixth Form. With some of the best outcomes in the East Riding, measures were comfortably above national averages. 50% of students gained at least one grade A or above and with 39% of all grades in the Sixth Form being A-A*, our students are well equipped for bright futures.

Getting to know people

Having our own common room enables the whole of sixth form to come together and participate in activities such as pub quizzes, the chilli challenge and Year 12 versus Year 13 event. There is a real buzz throughout the day. All of this has meant that over the two years you'll have the opportunity to make new friends and grow closer to those you already know. As your local provider with limited travel time, you have more time to engage in after school activities and study and our study facilities and the common room stay open until 6 pm so that you can make the most of your time.

















Enrichment Opportunity

Being a Sixth Form student is about so much more than just the subjects you choose. We want to ensure that you develop as an individual and can access experiences and opportunities that will help shape your future. Consequently, we offer a diverse enrichment programme which includes things such as a debate society, conversational Spanish lessons, learning sign language and driving theory support. In addition, we offer specialist support programmes like MEDSOC, HE+ and Employer focus, which support students considering applications to medicine, Oxbridge and degree level apprenticeships.

We have an active Student Union, that provides student leadership to make sure that the things you want to see happen actually do. This year included organising social events and charity fundraising, ensuring student well-being is a priority and listening to the voice of our students.
