RE: Health Expo Visit

All students in Year 12 and 13 Health and Social Care classes are invited on a visit to the Health Expo on 25 October 2023 at the Hilton Hotel in Hull.

This is a fantastic opportunity for your child to meet health providers from across the NHS and from private providers. It covers clinical health care, mental health, social work, paramedic science and many more health careers. Students will have the chance to take part in hands on workshops. They can talk to experts in their health care fields. It links with their course and helps them get a better understanding of the importance of building positive relationships in health and social care, equality and diversity, and experience active learning which links to unit 4 anatomy and physiology, unit 5 infection control and unit 10 nutrition for health.

This is a great opportunity for students to learn about career routes into health care and includes opportunities to meet apprenticeship providers including degree apprenticeships.

We will leave school on the school minibus at 9.30 am on Wednesday 25 October 2023 and arrive back at approximately 2.30 pm. Students should meet on West Playground for the bus on the morning. Students need to bring a bottle of water and a packed lunch. If your child is eligible for free school meals and requires a packed lunch providing for the visit, please indicate this on the consent form.
