RE: GCSE and A Level Drama Visit

The Drama department is pleased to be able to offer your child the opportunity to participate in a visit to Hull Truck Theatre to see Contact Theatre's new and exciting play, A Song for Ella *Grey.* The date of the theatre visit will be Wednesday 6 March 2024.

Students in Years 11, 12 and 13 are required to write a piece about a live theatre performance that they have watched as an audience member. This is an essential opportunity for students to see a professional performance, in preparation for their summer exam.

This performance will be a matinee performance; therefore we will be leaving school via coach at approximately 12.35 pm and returning to school at approximately 5.30 pm. As we will be leaving school at lunchtime students will need to bring a packed lunch. If your child is eligible for free school meals and requires a packed lunch providing for the visit please indicate this on the consent form. Additionally, as we are returning to school after the school buses have departed, you will need to make alternative arrangements for your child to travel home on this

As a school we work to ensure that the costs of all our visits are minimised, so that as many students as possible can take advantage of these valuable learning experiences. In this case, to be able to offer the visit we are requesting a contribution of £21 per student to cover ticket prices and transport costs.
