RE: A Level Geography Fieldwork Visit

Geography fieldwork is an important part of the course and we feel it offers an opportunity to widen knowledge and help students appreciate the content they are taught in the classroom.

We would like to offer your child the opportunity to take part in fieldwork and have organised a day trip to Sheffield on Friday 1 March 2024. This trip will be of real benefit to students as it links to a range of topics students are studying, including: changing spaces, making places, global migration and Earth's life support systems. We have a workshop booked at the Botanical gardens in the morning which will give students the opportunity to further study carbon sequestration and look at the 'grey to green project' set up alongside Sheffield University. The afternoon will be spent around the city centre developing case study knowledge.

The total price for the trip is £16 and this will help to cover transport for the day and the workshop. Additionally, students will need a small amount of money with them to purchase lunch on the day.
