RE: Secondary School Transition

Firstly, I hope you are keeping well. I am delighted that your child has been allocated a place at Driffield School and Sixth Form; we look forward to welcoming them to our school in September 2024.

We take our responsibilities very seriously when you entrust your child's education and care to us, and we will do everything we can to ensure that your child receives the care, support and guidance to thrive at Driffield School. We continue to be very proud of our students and really value the support we receive from our parents and the wider community.

As part of this, we aim to ensure the transition process from primary to secondary school runs as smoothly as possible to minimise any disruption or anxiety for you and your child. To support this, there are a number of stages to the transition process which are detailed below:

- Spring/summer term: a visit to your child's primary school by a member of our transition team.
- Thursday 27 June 2024: Induction Day for the Year 6 students and Induction Evening for parents/carers
- July 2024: Opportunity for a one-to-one interview with the Head of Year 7, at your request
- Autumn term 2024: Year 7 Pastoral Evening.


