Dear Parent or Carer,

**RE: Flamingo Land Trip**

We are delighted to invite your child on a visit to Flamingo Land. As Year 8 and Year 9 form tutors, we would like to provide an opportunity to take students from Year 8 and 9 on this visit on Saturday 13 July 2024. We would like those who have worked hard and demonstrated good behaviour throughout the year to have a fun day out and also further strengthen the positive relationships they have built.

We have been fortunate enough to secure one hundred tickets for this visit and this is the number of places we have available. There is a charge of £35 per student for this trip. Places are limited to 100 students and therefore if a very high uptake, names will be pulled out of the hat if the visit is oversubscribed. However, please note, the visit may not go ahead if costs are not covered.

Students will depart by two coaches from Driffield School at 8.30 am and arrive at Flamingo Land at approximately 9.30 am. Your child needs to arrive on West Playground no later than 8.15 am to allow for a prompt departure. We will return to school at approximately 6 pm, where students must be collected by a parent or carer unless stated otherwise on the consent form.

Students are advised to bring sun cream, a packed lunch and a refillable bottle to drink and suitable clothing depending on the weather conditions on the day. They may bring these in a bag or rucksack. They may also bring money or a bank card to purchase food, drink or souvenirs if they wish but this is at their own risk.

On Friday 14 June, we will write to confirm whether your child has been successful in gaining a place on the visit. If your child has gained a place, payment of the £35 will then need to be made via ParentPay by Monday 24 June. Please note, acceptance onto this trip is dependent on student behaviour. If we have any concerns prior to departure, this may result in your child being removed from the visit.

A meeting with students will take place nearer the time to finalise the details.
