

## Year 12

	Content covered
Topics	
Careers and Finance	Throughout the first half term students are taught several skills to help prepare them for life as a successful sixth form student. This includes organisation and planning their time effectively as well as professionalism, including how to send emails and correspondence appropriately. An introduction to our careers advisers also takes place as well as carrying out initial research into university/career opportunities to ensure they are building the correct pathway through the sixth form.
Relationships, Sex and Education	This program of study allows student to discuss important aspects relating to what makes a healthy relationship. This includes lessons on contraception, consent, coercion, pornography and fertility.
Risk and Safety	During this half term students consider how to keep themselves safe in life beyond the sixth form. As many students begin learning to drive this academic year, we discuss road safety during form time along with other topics including online safety, gambling awareness and alcohol awareness including the dangers of spiking. Guest speakers also talk to the year group regarding alcohol and drug awareness, road safety and gambling.
Healthy Lifestyles	Throughout this unit we discuss healthy eating, the necessity of sleep and how to practice good sleep hygiene as well as the dangers of smoking and vaping.  We also have guest speakers to discuss the issues surrounding county lines and provision from MIND.
Identity and Diversity	The identity and diversity unit discusses issues relating to disabilities and discrimination, racism and trans issues with the focus being on respect. Guest speakers include representatives from the Anthony Nolan trust.
Global Citizenship	The final unit of year 12 begins with 'an equal opportunity to gain advice' which discusses how students can access wider services available to them including how to contact their local MP and their rights to do so. We then discuss how to debate, the student union and the benefits of volunteering. We then finish the unit with preparations for the application process to university and apprenticeships which begin in the autumn term.



## Year 13

Topics	Content covered
Careers and Finance	In Year 13 the careers and finance unit is focused on next steps following on from sixth form. We finalise UCAS personal statement along with considering 'what makes a quality apprenticeship', CV and interview skills, as well confidence building. Students also have the opportunity to have a 1:1 careers interview with our specialist careers adviser.
Relationships, Sex and Education	In this half term we revisit many aspects discussed in the previous relationships unit with a focus on what makes a healthy relationship. We also revisit the topics of contraception and consent. Guest speakers also speak to the year 13 students regarding testicular cancer awareness.
Intervention 1:1 timetable	Following mock exams at the beginning of this half term the tutor programme makes way for 1:1 conversations with both form tutors and member of the sixth form team, where students are assigned mentors to assist with the final run up to exams. Students are also offered 'revision blast' sessions every morning during form time where they have 20 minutes with a specialist for each of their subjects to develop exam techniques.
