## RE: GCSE Results Day, Thursday 21 August 2025

I hope you are all beginning to enjoy your summer break and having a well-earned rest following your recent examinations. I am writing to give you some information about your results day this summer.

Your results day is Thursday 21 August 2025. You can collect your results from the Sixth Form Common Room from 9 am. A copy of your results will also be sent to your school email address at approximately 9.30 am.

If you are unable to collect your results on results day, please contact the exams office (exams@driffieldschool.org.uk) and we can make alternative arrangements for you.

If your parent or carer wish to receive a copy of your results, then you need to inform the school that you give your permission for this to happen. You can do this by emailing exams@driffieldschool.org.uk from your school email account with the following statement: "I give my permission for my parent [insert name] to also receive the email containing my exam results. Please can you send that email to [insert parent email address]."

## Sixth Form Enrolment

After you have collected a copy of results you can then meet with the Sixth Form Team and enrol in the Sixth Form if you wish to do so.

- If you have met the entry requirements for your original option choices, you will have a pre-signed green form in your envelope. If you have a green form and still wish to study your original options, you just need to sign the form and place it in the container provided in the Sixth Form Common Room.
- All students will be given a yellow form in their envelopes to use should they wish to change their original option choices. If you have not met the entry requirements for your original option choices, you need to use this form to enrol.
- If you are enrolling with a yellow form, you will go to the Sixth Form Study Centre to speak to Mr Andrews, Mrs Amers and the available Subject Leaders to discuss your options.

Finally, can I also ask that if you have any resources, such as textbooks for your subjects, that you return these to the school when you come in to collect your results.



Alternatively, those who are coming in for Sixth Form activate day can return books on this day. It is important that we are able to equip next year's GCSE students.
