### RE: Driffield School and Sixth Form Year 6 Open Evening

We are delighted to invite you to our Year 6 Open Evening on Thursday 25 September 2025.

On 25 September, the school will be open between 5 pm and 7.30 pm. Parents will have the opportunity to attend a presentation from key members of staff and tour the school. This will enable you and your child to visit our subject facilities and meet with departmental staff. Many of the departments will also be demonstrating the resources at their disposal, displaying students' work and providing opportunities for the Year 6 students to get involved in some activities. Staff will also be available to answer any queries you may have.

To give you and your child an idea of what is on offer at Driffield School & Sixth Form we have arranged the following programme:

- Our Open Evening will take place on **Thursday 25 September starting at 5 pm for all parents.**
- There will be a main presentation to all parents. To enable everyone to attend the main presentation we have two staggered slots available.
- **Presentation 1** will start at 5.30 pm in the North Hall and in order to best manage numbers attending we would ask parents of children currently attending **Driffield Junior School** to meet in the **North Hall** for a prompt **5.30 pm** start. Parents in this group are invited to visit and view the activities and displays put on by subject areas following the presentation.
- **Presentation 2** will take place in the **North Hall** for parents of children in **ALL other feeder schools and non-feeder schools**. This will start promptly at **6.30 pm**. From 5pm and 6.30pm parents in this group are invited to visit and view the activities and displays put on by subject areas.
- There will be information stands and complimentary refreshments and menu samples in the Sixth Form common room.

There is ample parking available on the school site which can be entered via the main Manorfield Road entrance or alongside Driffield Leisure Centre off Bridlington Road, leading onto the playgrounds at the rear of the centre.
