Dear Parent or Carer,

RE: Literacy Visit to Flemingate

We have an exciting opportunity for your child to take part in a trip to Flemingate in Beverley with Mrs Hood. They will work with the *Run With It* company and complete a range of literacy and numeracy activities around the Flemingate complex. The activities are designed to help them use maths and English skills in a real-life context and to support their wider personal development.

The visit will take place on Tuesday 24 March. It will run during the school day departing at 9.15 am by minibus and returning by 2.45 pm. Students should register as normal and then go to the West Canteen at the start of period 1 to meet Mrs Hood.

Students must wear normal school uniform and ensure that they are wearing suitable footwear for walking around for the full day. They will need to bring their pencil case, along with a packed lunch and drink. Students will be walking around the Flemingate complex and may be outside for some time, so should bring an appropriate waterproof coat in case of rain, or sun cream in case of sunshine.
