RE: GCSE Mathematics Revision Sessions

As you will be aware the maths exams for all Y11 students are on the following dates:

- Thursday 14 May (non-calculator)
- Wednesday 3 June (calculator allowed)
- Wednesday 10 June (calculator allowed)

In the lead up to these we will continue to offer our usual lunchtime and after school revision sessions. Students also have access to the whole of MathsWatch to use as a revision aid.

The maths department are also offering 2 additional revision sessions:

Wednesday 13 May – Non-calculator revision

We are running a Wednesday after school revision session on 13 May on the eve of the first maths exam paper. This will be a fantastic opportunity to focus on non-calculator skills and all maths teachers will be available to support. This will run straight after school in usual maths classrooms up to 4.30 pm.

Saturday 6 June – Calculator revision

We also have a booster session on Saturday 6 June running from 9 am to 12 noon in the maths classrooms in North building. This has been planned to be delivered before the final maths paper. This will give us an opportunity to specifically target topics that have not yet been covered and so are most likely to be on the final paper.

Please note, the canteen will not be open on the Saturday morning, so your child should bring a drink and snack with them if they wish. It would be extremely helpful for your child to bring their maths exam equipment to the revision sessions.

We strongly recommend that your child attends these sessions to give them the best opportunity to be fully prepared for their exams. These boosters are open to all students, but we would appreciate it if you could register if your child will be attending the Saturday morning session by Friday 22 May.
