In January 2026, Driffield School students competed in the Humberside Schools Cross Country Championships in Scunthorpe, taking part in a fantastic event with 735 athletes on the day.

In the Year 7 races, Jacob Ollett finished an impressive 8th out of 131, while Maisie Doolin and Neve Greenwood came 27th and 33rd respectively out of 117 runners.

In the Year 9 girls' category, Olivia Ogden finished 44th and Taryn Ollet 93rd out of 128.

In the Year 10–11 girls' race, Year 10 student Evie Lakes produced an impressive 2nd place, running against girls a year above her, while Josie Green finished 32nd. Ollie Burchett was 14th in the Year 10–11 boys' race.

Our Sixth Form athletes also performed strongly, with Will Wortley, Tom Long, and Harry Sutton finishing 4th, 5th, and 7th, and Emily Collinge and Amelia Crawford finishing 3rd and 5th.

The top eight athletes in each category progress to the English Schools Championships, which this year will be held in Liverpool on Saturday 14th March. We wish those competing the very best of luck.
