Dear Parent or Carer,

RE: Year 6 Induction Day and Information Evening

We are delighted to invite your child to visit Driffield School for an induction day as part of our Year 6 transition process. Further details are provided below, along with information about the parental information evening that complements the induction day.

Induction Day

Students are invited to attend as indicated below:

Thursday 25 June: **all primary schools**

The school day starts at 8.40 am and students arriving on foot should aim to arrive for this time via the entrance on Manorfield Road or via the leisure centre (the other entrances on Bridlington Road will not be accessible). Members of the transition team will be present on the school gates to meet and greet students as they arrive and will escort them to the East Hall. We ask that all students arrive in their full primary school uniform and bring a pencil case, bottle of water and a snack for break time (this **must not** contain any nuts). Students travelling on buses will be met by a sixth form student and/or transition ambassadors to ensure their first school bus journey is a smooth one. A pass for travelling on the school bus is attached, along with the school bus timetable.

The day will consist of a welcome assembly, tour of the school and sample subject lessons. Students have the option of a free hot or cold school dinner or to bring their own packed lunch.

At the end of the day, students will return to the East Hall. To ensure the safe departure of all students could I please ask that you complete the form below confirming how your child will be getting home by Friday 22 May. Students walking home will be escorted to the area in front of ACE Reception or to the exit to Bridlington Road. Please note that students will not be allowed out through the leisure centre exit due to the school buses using this. If you are wanting to arrange to pick your child up by car, please use the car park on Manorfield Road. Students who are taking a bus home will be escorted to the buses from 3.20 pm. Bronte & Holtby – West Hall
Johnson & Mortimer – North Hall

Maths equipment packs will also be available to purchase on the evening for £12. This will include a CASIO Scientific calculator, FX-83GT CW+ (where possible please bring exact change for these).

If, after your child's induction day and the information evening, you would still like to meet a member of the transition team in person, there will be an opportunity for you to book an appointment via the email address below. Your child will find out their house and form group on their induction day.

In addition to the transition days in school, we have scheduled visits to each of the primary schools to reassure students of the transition process.

For parents and carers of students with SEND, there will be an opportunity to meet with a member of the SEND team at Driffield School. This will take place on Wednesday 17 June from 4 – 6.30 pm. To make an appointment, please contact Mrs Naylor on 01377 253631.
