RE: Cambridge National - Sports Studies course

As part of your child's Cambridge National Sports Studies course, they are assessed in component R187 Increasing Awareness of Outdoor and Adventurous Activities. Having studied the course specification in-depth, we firmly believe that this unit gives our students the best opportunity of achieving high marks.

In order to undertake this unit, we would like your child to attend an activity that will involve walking a trail surrounding the village of Fridaythorpe. The route will be approximately 14km long, covering different forms of terrain. This activity is a compulsory component of the course and will contribute significantly to the student's overall grade.

The activity will be supervised by staff members from Driffield School & Sixth Form. Due to the nature of the activity being undertaken by the students it is imperative that behaviour is of a high standard. Any students who do not meet these standards may be excluded from the activities with parents or carers being contacted.

Students will be attending the trip in their teaching group on the following date:

- 10C/St1 – Wednesday 15 July 2026

Students need to arrive directly to the ACE reception at 8.30 am to be registered and they will return to school at approximately 3.30 pm. Students do not need to wear school uniform, instead they need to wear comfortable sports clothing appropriate for a long walk e.g. tracksuit, shorts, t-shirt, trainers, raincoat etc.

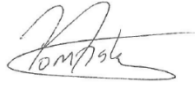
Students must bring:
